- 13. It is absolutely important that every leader must pray every day for his portion of wisdom.
- 14. Leaders must use initiative as this is the ingredient that moves them forward in life while others are standing still.
- 15. A leader sees opportunities and solutions and does not focus on problems. The difference lies in how you approach every task, assignment and challenge.
